

Seize the DAISIES

Embellish dangle earrings with tiny spacers

Daisy spacers border a briolette centerpiece, adding swing to these quick and easy earrings. Customize the dangles to your preferred length by varying the number of coils in the wire wraps.



SupplyList

- 2 5 x 8mm briolettes
- 12 3mm daisy spacers
- 12 in. (30cm) 24-gauge half-hard wire
- pair of decorative earring wires
- chainnose and roundnose pliers
- diagonal wire cutters



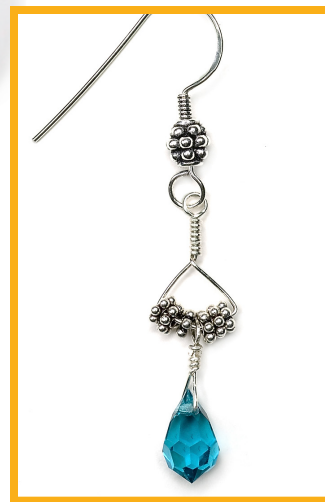
1 Cut a 3-in. (7.6cm) piece of wire. String a briolette and make a set of wraps as in a top-drilled bead (Basics). Make a wrapped loop (Basics) above the wraps.



2 Cut a 3-in. (7.6cm) piece of wire. Center three spacers, the briolette unit, and three spacers.



3 Make a set of wraps as in a top-drilled bead. Make a wrapped loop above the wraps.



4 Open the loop of an earring wire and attach the dangle. Close the loop. Make a second earring to match the first. ♣
